Nothing in modern history compares to the level of social destruction, deaths and economic cost inflicted on America due to marijuana and other drugs. There are roughly 305 overdose deaths every dayⁱ, 133 daily shooting deathsⁱⁱ, 135 suicides a dayⁱⁱⁱ, and 106 traffic deaths a day due to drugs.^{iv}

That totals 679.

Add deaths from cancer, cardiac arrest, and other drug related health causes and the total is easily 1,000 deaths a day. The economic cost is calculated at \$3.73 trillion including intangibles.^v

This is a national security issue demanding immediate action.

By now it should be apparent that we cannot control the supply of drugs. Nor can we win the drug war by ignoring prevention and just treating victims, or turning our back on crime and enforcement of narcotic laws. Nor can we survive as a nation by allowing the continuation of the **ridiculous federal drug policy** called "**Harm Reduction**" which **encourages drug use, ignores prevention in favor of offering treatment** for the victims, and **does not hold drug users accountable for crimes**. Soros, the author, explains the origin in his book (2006) *The Age of Fallibility*:

*"...What I knew for sure was that the war on drugs was doing more harm than good and that we had to explore ways to reduce the harm that drug addiction causes. That was the approach I advocated under the name of "**harm reduction.**" By "harm" caused by the war on drugs: **the high rates of incarceration**; the disruption of African American and Hispanic communities; the producing countries turning into narco-states, and corruption and abuse of power. ... **I joined with others to fund state ballot initiatives to legalize marijuana for medical purposes, to require treatment instead of incarceration for drug possession ... and I supported the creation of a national organization, the Drug Policy Alliance, to advocate for harm reduction practices and principles ..."***



Beginning with the Obama Administration starting in 2008 "Harm Reduction" has been the basis of federal drug policy, with catastrophic results.

The marijuana market has grown from about 15 million to 55 million^{vi}. The potency has increased from about 6% to as high as 99% for use in edibles, dabbing and vaping. Overdose deaths have grown from about 105 to over 300 a day.

Marijuana is the major cause of the nation's crisis of **mental health, addiction, and suicides**. Marijuana induced psychosis **is a factor in almost all mass killings and homicides. Roughly 20% of drivers are mentally impaired.**

Marijuana also causes **brain damage, loss of IQ for adolescents, and physical and mental damage to a fetus, and their progeny.**
